Call to Order of Regular Commission Meeting

Chairman Cortner called the meeting to order at 10:06 AM.

Consent Agenda:

Board Action: Commissioner Huff made a motion to accept the consent agenda. Commissioner Hopf provided a second to the motion. The Board asked the Rosenbauer invoice be held until the engine is delivered. With no further discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Chief's Report

Chief Patterson discussed October activity. It was very busy with 195 calls. Training and facilities were discussed. Personnel changes were discussed as well.

Commissioner Reports

Commissioner Huff discussed the revenue advisory committee and timber sales revenue. The Board discussed how best to advocate for harvesting timber. PILT and Title 3 funds were discussed. The Board was in consensus on make a request for PILT funds from the County. An item will be added to the December agenda.

1. Policy 14.12 Electronic Funds Transfer: Discuss and take action

Typos were discussed and corrected.

Board Action: Commissioner Hopf made a motion to approve the Policy 14.12 with typo corrections. Commissioner Huff provided a second to the motion, and with no discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

2. Policy 14.13 Fraud Prevention and Reporting: Discuss and take action

Board Action: Commissioner Huff made a motion to accept Policy 14.13. Commissioner Hopf provided a second to the motion, and with no discussion the motion carried unanimously.

3. 2021-2023 Audit Results: Discussion

Audit results were circulated and discussed. An accountability and financial audit is expected in 2026.

4. Resolution 2024-09 Transfer of Funds from Reserve: Discuss and take action

Board Action: Chairman Cortner made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-09. Commissioner Hopf provided a second to the motion, and with no discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

5. 2025 Trusteed Application: Chairman signature

Chairman Cortner signed the application for 2025 participation. Domestic partnership definition and participation were discussed.

6. General Liability Insurance: Discussion

Chief Patterson discussed preliminary CIAW rates for 2025 at \$85,000. ESIP has not yet provided a quote.

7. Power Lift Gurney Purchase: Discuss and take action

The Board approved the purchase of a used powerlift gurney system at a \$10,000 savings over new.

8. Revenue Advisory Committee/PILT Funds: Discussion

The Revenue Advisory Committee and PILT funds were discussed earlier in the meeting.

9. Retreat/Planning Session: Discuss and take action

Chairman Cortner suggested scheduling a retreat in January or February. The agenda will be set in December at the regular meeting.
